- Review and sign your LRAP Award.
- Enroll and graduate from our college, with a bachelor's degree.
- Work at least an average of 30 hours per week – in any profession, or more than one job (if needed).
- Begin repaying your federal, private alternative or parent PLUS loans.

Take Your Education Further

1. CONSIDER YOUR TRANSFER CREDITS

We accept credits for courses taken at accredited institutions with a grade of 2.0 or above, if the course is comparable to a course offered at Saint Joseph's and is relevant to your proposed program of study.

Credit can also be awarded for military experience, Advanced Placement exam scores, credit-by-examination, or an experiential learning portfolio. Credit for coursework taken at non-accredited institutions may be granted on a provisional basis. Students must complete a minimum of 32 credits at Saint Joseph's College in order to meet degree requirements.

2. PLAN YOUR FINANCES

Financial aid is available in the form of merit scholarships, federal grants and loans, and work-study programs. Our Transfer Scholarships for campus

students range from \$11,000 to \$19,000 to help make SJC an affordable option. Ask about our Visit Scholarship. Apply for financial aid by filing your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after January 1 each year, to ensure you receive the maximum amount of available aid.

3. APPLY NOW

Use the Common App or SJC App to apply online. Make sure to add Saint Joseph's College to your list of "My Colleges."
